Dear Parents and Carers.

We continue to be so very impressed with the Year 11 students' work ethic and conduct when engaging with their lessons, intervention sessions and exams.

We have carefully considered what is in their best interests as they continue their exams after the half term break. With this in mind we will be allowing students to work independently at home from Monday 3rd June to continue their preparations for their remaining exams. Students will be expected to come to school in full school uniform with their equipment at 8:30am for morning exams. Students will go to their form room and see their form tutor as normal who will go through exam reminders before students complete their exams. For all afternoon exams, students will enter via the main student gate and then go through the construction gate to enter the school hall. Students should arrive no earlier than 1.15 pm.

We remain committed to ensuring that students are receiving specialist input from their teachers. As such, teachers will still be contactable to offer support to students. If your child has any specific questions regarding their revision, they can contact their teacher via email, who will be able to respond during school hours. In addition, the revision timetable remains in place and will provide students with the opportunity to come to school, in their full school uniform, to receive input specific to the exam taking place on the proceeding day.
