Dear Parents and Carers,

## I am writing to you to share the 2025-2026 Term Dates and to confirm that following our consultation we will be formalising the two-week October half term moving forward.

Thank you to the parents who responded to our consultation on the two-week October half term. We have read all responses and analysed the results. Stopsley High School's parents and carers, 87% were in favour of making the two-week half term a permanent part of our annual calendar. We have also consulted with staff and reviewed the impact of the calendar change on the delivery of the curriculum.

Apologies that in the first edition of the letter it incorrectly stated that there had been a decline in attendance having introduced the additional week when instead it should have stated there was a decline in absence of both staff and students resulting in therefore improved attendance. This is also reflected in the feedback from staff and also in the comments from parents and carers in the survey.

Therefore, next year's term dates will be as follows:
